Microwave Apple Crisp

- 4 lg Granny Smith apples-peeled, cored sliced
- 1/2 cup butter, melted
- 3/4 cup packed brown sugar
- 3/4 cup quick cooking oats
- 1/2 cup all-purpose flour
- 1 tsp cinnamon
- 1/2 tsp allspice
- 1. Spread the apples evenly in 8" square baking dish. In a medium bowl, mix together the melted butter, brown sugar, oats, flour, cinnamon & allspice. Sprinkle this topping over the apples.
- 2. Cook on full power in the microwave for 10-12 minutes, until apples can be easily pierced w/a knife. ENJOY!
